

SNAP into BabySteps



Save for your child's future



Every Massachusetts child who is enrolled in the BabySteps Savings Plan with a MEFA U.Fund 529 account and the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) before their first birthday is eligible to receive a monthly deposit of \$10 into their U.Fund 529 account for one year.

This benefit will be added to the BabySteps \$50 seed deposit, provided when the U.Fund 529 account is opened, making the total value of deposits \$170.

As soon as families enroll in BabySteps by opening a U.Fund 529 account, they can start saving on their own to plan for their children's educational aspirations! Visit mass.gov/BabySteps to get started.

Once families have opened a U.Fund 529 account for their child through BabySteps, they can complete a simple online form to receive the additional "SNAP into BabySteps" monthly deposit by visiting mass.gov/SNAPIntoBabySteps.

Families have up to 18 months from their children's birth to enroll in the program.
